- USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament. Prohibited balls include all balls with a balance hole (hole(s) not used for delivery) and any ball not on the USBC Approved Ball List.
- Field is limited to 72 bowlers with current USBC youth membership status. Enrolled high schoolers with USBC Adult membership may compete if SafeSport training has been completed. Bowlers participating in Collegiate bowling activities are not eligible.
- The Top 20 Tournament is a scratch competition divided into two divisions: Boys and Girls
- Entry Fee is \$65. Lane fees are \$35.00 and \$30.00 will go to the award fund from each entry.
- OPTIONAL high game (\$1/game = \$10), singles brackets (\$5/entry; games 1/2/3 & 4/5/6), and doubles brackets (\$5/bowler, \$10 per bracket, may enter multiple brackets but only once per partner, games 8/9/10) will be available at check-in, cash only, paid via SMART.
- No entry fees will be returned. The award fund, including added scholarship monies, will be returned 100% via Scholarship Management Accounting Reports for Tenpins (SMART) account #9236.
- Entries can be emailed to Rachel Toney at Rachel_ohbowling@outlook.com, and payment sent via CashApp (\$gnrtoney), Venmo (@gnrtoney), or Zelle (850-496-2552). Alternatively, entries can be received and paid in cash at Oak Hills Bowling Center front desk. Registration closes at noon on Saturday, April 29, 2023. No late registrations accepted.
- All bowlers must be ready to provide current USBC membership verification (and SafeSport completion as applicable) at check-in. Lane assignment and rotation will be provided on the recap sheet.
- Each bowler will bowl a ten (10) game, non-stop marathon on challenge conditions, moving one pair of lanes each game. Bowlers are expected to bowl when it is their turn and not delay the event.
- Total scratch score will determine the Top 20 of each division. The top boy and girl are each guaranteed a \$1,000.00 SMART award. A tie for division champion will be decided by a one (1) game roll-off bowled on a designated pair of lanes. The bowler with the highest game gets lane preference with the bowler on the odd lane starting. For all other ties, monies will be combined and split evenly to the competitors. With the exception of 1st Place, division award funds will be percentage distributed to the Top 20 based on the fund available (\$30 x # of division bowlers + added SMART; sample award distribution on reverse).
- All bowlers must wear shirts or jerseys with collars and sleeves. No t-shirts are allowed. Boys may wear slacks or dress shorts. Girls may wear slacks, skirts, skorts or dress shorts; must be longer than the bowlers' fingertips when standing. No jeans, leggings, sweatpants, are allowed. Bowlers are not permitted to use headphones, wear hats or other headgear, ripped or torn clothing, or basketball shorts. No clothing with offensive language or graphics, or any apparel which the tournament director feels is inappropriate.
- Proper behavior, lane etiquette, and one lane courtesy is expected at all times.
- Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made to tournament director in writing within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament director will be final unless a written appeal is filed with USBC Headquarters within the time limits in Rule 329.
