Tournament Rules

- 1. Doubles partners can be mixed or same gender.
- 2. Scotch doubles format will be used: Leadoff bowler will roll the first ball and the partner will shoot the spare (if any). If the leadoff bowler gets a strike, the partner becomes the leadoff bowler for the next frame. Bowlers will swap leadoff position for the first frame of each game.
- To figure the composite average: Bowler 1 average + Bowler 2 average / 2 Each average must consist of at least 21 games. If bowler does not have 21 games for the 2018 winter season, then average from the 2017 winter season will be used. Handicap will be 80% of 200.
- 4. Entries due by 9AM the day of the tournament. Participants may bowl in both squads but not with the same partner.
- 5. In the event of a tie, the prize money for that position will be divided equally.
- 6. In case of mechanical failure, participants may be moved to the next available pair of lanes.
- 7. USBC rules and regulations shall apply.
- 8. All decisions of the tournament management are final.
