

Thirty Frame Game-Rules and Sample Scoring

Enter online at TournamentBowl.com



1 Eligibility: Open to all bowlers of any age. This is not a USBC sanctioned tournament.

2 Tournament date: Saturday, July 29, 2023. Check-in starts at 9:15 am. Bowling starts at 10:00 am.

3 Cost: \$35 tournament entry (\$45 late registration and walk-ins). \$5 optional brackets, no limit. \$20 lineage; \$15 to prize fund. Pay at check-in.

4 Divisions:

*Under 13 (youth); birthdate 8/1/2010 or later

*Age 13-18 (youth); birthdate 8/1/2004 to 7/31/2010

*Adults

5 Registration: Register online at TournamentBowl.com by scanning the QR code or searching upcoming tournaments in NE.

6 Format: Each bowler will bowl a total of 30 frames on a house pattern. **Only one ball per bowler is allowed.**

Bowlers may practice with multiple balls, but must choose only one ball for competition. Each frame has a different scoring format. Payouts in each division will be based on the number of entries per division. Youth bowlers will receive all payouts in SMART scholarships. Adults will receive cash or have the option to donate their payouts to the youth scholarship fund. Additional prize money will be added on tournament day.

7 Dress Code: Tournament dress is encouraged but not required. Please dress in clean clothing with no obscene gestures or pictures.

8 Alcohol consumption: Adults age 21 and older may consume alcoholic beverages.
