### 2023 Utah Youth Challenge Tournament

#### Hosted by Bonwood Bowl, Miracle Bowl and Valley Lanes

Tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) rules and regulations in addition to rules adopted by the tournament organizers. Tournament Director/Officials have final decisions regarding anything not covered by these rules.

- 1. Dates: August 20-22, 2021
- 2. Times: Block 1: Saturday July 29th @ 8:00 am (Bonwood), Block 2: Saturday July 30th @ 2:00 pm (Valley Lanes), Block 3: Sunday July 30 22nd @ 8:30 am (Miracle Bowl)

**3.** Format: Each bowler will complete a 5-game block at each of the 3 bowling centers, 15 games total. Bowlers must participate in all 4 blocks. The tournament will be divided into 3 divisions as listed below. At the end of 3 blocks, the top 5 bowlers from each division will participate in a stepladder final. The 1<sup>st</sup> match will be the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place in a roll off. The winner will advance to bowl against the 2<sup>nd</sup> place seed. The winner of that match will advance to bowl against the 1<sup>st</sup> place seed. In the event of a tie for fifth place, the bowler with the highest 5 game block will advance. There will be a different Challenge shot for each block. The lanes will not be re-oiled for the stepladder finals.

- 4. Average: Entering average will be the 2022-2023 composite average as reported on Bowl.com. The composite average will include any winter leagues that have not been reported.
- 5. Divisions: There will be 3 divisions:
  - a. Uinta Division: 175 and Higher, Scratch
  - b. Wasatch Division: 140-174, Handicap 90% of 185.
  - c. Oquirrh Division: 139 and under, Handicap 90% of 150.

Any bowler with an average of 174 or under may chose to participate in the Uinta division, if they would prefer. If a bowler enters with an average of 135 or higher, they may move to the Wasatch Division.

- 6. Cost: \$70.00 \$55.00 for lineage, \$15.00 for prize fund Payment for entry will be accepted by cash, Venmo or Credit Card. A \$2.00 service fee will be charged with each card transaction.
- 7. Awards: Prizes will be awarded with a ratio of at least 1:5. Prizes paid out in all divisions will be in the form of Scholarships to the SMART Fund. Scholarships will be awarded for block winners as well as overall winners.
- 8. Eligibility: This tournament is open to all Youth bowlers with a current USBC card, who participated in youth bowling during the 2022-2023 year.
- 9. Junior Gold Qualifier: There will be a Junior Gold Qualifier during this tournament. Please see the Qualifier Rules separately from this entry.
- 10. Equipment: All equipment must be in compliance with the USBC rules that are in effect as of August 1, 2021. This specifically pertains to the recently changed rules regarding elimination of balance holes and use of holes for gripping purposes only. Refer to USBC Equipment Specifications and Certifications Manual for further information, details and requirements.
- 11. Check In: Pre-registered entrants are requested to check in 30 minutes before squad starting time. Walk-in entrants must register and check in 1 hour prior to squad starting time.
- 12. Protest: Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager within 72 hours of tournament close. Errors in scoring must be reported at the time the error is entered. Unexpected situations will be handled by the tournament management.
- 13. Dress Code: The Dress Code Will Be Strictly Enforced. All participants may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans, skorts and shorts. Shorts and skorts length must go beyond the fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides. Participants must wear a shirt with sleeves; preferably a collared shirt. Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to: Hats (except for medical reasons), tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc, workout attire, lounge pants, bib overalls, jeans that are torn (skin showing), not clean or in poor condition. Attire with inappropriate, questionable, or offensive language or graphics. There are NO exceptions.
- 14. Conduct: Bowlers are responsible for their conduct. Tournament officials have the right to disqualify any bowler whose conduct is derogatory or detrimental to the best interests of the tournament. No unreasonable delay in the progress of any game is permitted. (USBC rule 11) Absolutely NO alcohol consumption during the youth tournament within any of the assigned lanes (including the buffer). Only assigned bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the bowling area during competition (including the buffer).
- 15. Electronic Devices: Electronic devices will be permitted in the settee area as long as they are not causing a distraction to other bowers, disturbance or a delay in the pace of bowling. Any youth found in violation will be required to put their electronic device away.
- 16. Liability: The entrants whose names appear thereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the organizers of this tournament and Utah State USBC, its officers or agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fee, if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies of cause relating thereto or resulting there from, fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond its control.
- 17. The tournament directors reserve the right to address changes, concerns or happenings not addressed in these rules, as they deem appropriate for the tournament.
