# YOUTH LEAGUE FUNDRAISER TOURNAMENT RULES

Date: July 29, 2023 10:00 AM Venue: Meridian Lanes

#### 1. Format:

- The tournament will follow a no tap format. Averages are based on end of 2022-23 season of minimum 21 games. If player does have an established average, no tap will be set at 9. <80 No tap 6, 81-99 No tap 7, 100-150 No tap 8, >151 No tap 9
- No tap scoring means that if a bowler knocks down nine pins on the first ball of a frame, it will count as a strike.
- All other USBC bowling rules will apply unless otherwise specified.

#### 2. Eligibility:

- The tournament is open to all interested bowlers, regardless of skill level or age.
- Participation does not required USBC membership

#### 3. Registration:

- Participants must register in advance to secure their spot in the tournament.
- Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Youth ages up to 17 \$15 / Adults 18+ \$25 / Entry fees do not include shoe rental.

#### 4. Schedule:

- The tournament will be held on July 29, 2023, at Meridian Lanes. Late players after frame 3 forfeit entry fee.
- Participants are expected to arrive early and be ready for their designated time slot.

#### 5. Equipment:

- Participants may bring their own bowling balls and shoes or use those provided by the venue.
- Bowling balls must meet the specifications outlined by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC).

#### 6. Scoring:

- The scoring system will be based on a no tap format of 3 games.
- A no tap strike will be awarded if the bowler knocks down nine pins on the first ball.
- A regular strike (all ten pins knocked down) will also be awarded.
- A spare will be counted as ten pins plus the number of pins knocked down on the next ball.
- A perfect game will be awarded to a bowler who scores 300, regardless of the no tap format.

#### 7. Rules and Etiquette:

- All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner.
- Respect for fellow participants, officials, and the venue is essential.
- Participants must adhere to the venue's rules and regulations.
- Alcohol will only be served and consumed on the adult 'high' side of the lanes 17-32

#### 8. Disputes and Rulings:

- The tournament officials' decisions are final and binding.
- In case of disputes or rule clarifications, participants may approach the designated tournament officials.

#### 9. Awards:

- \$10 of entry adult entry fees will go to adult prize fund / \$5 of youth entry fees will go to youth prize fund
- Adult awards will be cash / Youth awards will be USBC SMART Account Scholarship. If youth winners do not have a USBC membership, then cash awards will be given to parent/guardian.
- Prizes are awarded on a 6:1 8:1 schedules based on a total of 3 no tap games.
- Winners will be recognized and rewarded based on their final scores.
- The tournament organizer will distribute prizes at the end of the event.
- Note: Tournament organizers reserve the right to distribute awards according to overall funds received and lineage fees.
- Participants may donate all or partial awards to Meridian Junior Bowlers
