Gr Pensacola 2024-2025 City Tournament Rules

- Eligibility All entrants must be sanctioned by the United States Bowling Congress and be a current member of the Greater Pensacola USBC Association with at least 9 games in a 2024-2025 GPUSBCA sanctioned league as of October 18, 2024. USBC Rules and Regulations will govern this tournament.
- Averages All contestants will use their highest 2023-2024 GPUSBCA yearbook average of 21 games or more. Bowlers without a GPUSBCA 2023-2024 yearbook average will use their highest <u>Bowl.com</u> 2023-2024 21 or more games average. If bowler has neither of these, we will use their highest 2024-2025 average of 21 games or more. If no average, bowler will bowl scratch. USBC Rule 319 A-2, "10 Pin Rule", <u>is in effect</u>. Youth averages will not be accepted. IT SHALL BE EACH BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE. FAILURE TO USE THE CORRECT AVERAGE SHALL DISQUALIFY SCORE. PRIZE WINNINGS SHALL BE BASED ON THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE IF IT IS HIGHER THAN THE CORRECT AVERAGE.
- 3. **Handicap** Handicap shall be based on 90% of 230 with <u>No Maximum handicap</u>. A right-handed bowler with an established right-handed average must bowl right-handed. Similarly, a left-handed average bowler must bowl left-handed. 2-handed delivery is approved as long as it is the established average of that bowler.
- 4. Re-Rate While Tournament Management reserves the right to rerate an entrant, such rerating or adjusting of their legal average should be done by the bowler before the date and time he/she starts to bowl. Local Association Championship re-rating must follow the procedure specified under USBC RULE 319e.
- 5. **Multiple Participation** Bowlers may participate up to two (2) times in the **Team** event (provided lineup does not include more than two members from another team entry); however, the first team event counts toward ALL events. Bowlers may participate up to two (2) times in the **Doubles** event (provided lineup does not include the same Doubles partner for each entry); however, the first doubles event counts toward ALL events. Singles may be bowled twice with the first scores counting in the **ALL** events. You may only cash once in Singles.
- 6. **Entries** All entries and fees must be in the hands of the Tournament Manager or postmarked no later than midnight October 15, 2024. No refunds will be made after the entry has been received and scheduled to bowl. The entry fee is \$45.00 per person, per event. Scratch Singles, Scratch Doubles & Scratch All Events (optional) are \$20 each. All other optional events are \$10.00.
- 7. **Scheduling -** The team captain will be contacted if the 1st choice of squad dates & times is not available. **No written confirmations will be sent.** Three (3) complete games shall be bowled by each team or individual in each event they enter. Singles and Doubles will be scheduled with a maximum of three (3) entries to a pair of lanes. **Singles will be bowled first and all six (6) games of the Singles/Doubles squad will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.** Additional squads may be added, if necessary.
- 8. Check-in <u>All bowlers should check-in at the tournament table 45 minutes prior to scheduled bowling time.</u> Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with the score counting, beginning with the frame then being bowled. A team refusing to start because a full line-up is not present shall forfeit all games by declining to bowl. WALK-INS AND RE-ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED UNTIL 60 MINUTES PRIOR TO SQUAD TIME.
- 9. **Replacements** Replacements will be authorized after submitting a substitution request by the team captain or appointee. All substitution requests should be made to the Tournament Manager at least one (1) hour before the bowler's squad time.
- Official Score The signed recap sheet will be the official score following verification from the computer printout.
- 11. **Ties** First place ties in any event will be bowled within 10 days after the close of the tournament with the date and time set by the Tournament Manager. The association will pay the expense of a **1** game roll-off. When a tie for other than 1st place occurs, the prize money will be combined and divided equally among the tied position winners.
- 12. **Prizes** All prize money will be returned 100%. A ratio of 1 place for every 8 entries, team, singles and doubles. All Events and other optional events will be paid 1 for every 10. If a team enters scratch all members of the team must enter scratch. Additionally, if a doubles pair enters scratch both individuals must enter scratch. A prize list and bowling schedule will be posted in the tournament host center 24 hours prior to the beginning of the tournament. All prize monies will be awarded within 30 days after the close of the tournament (provided there are no protests). Team captains are responsible for distributing the prize money to their team members within 7 days after receipt of prize money.
- Management The Tournament Manager shall have the authority to decide matters pertaining to the operation
 of this tournament. **THE LANES ASSIGNED TO YOU ARE THE LANES YOU BOWL ON** (No exceptions!)
- 14. Tournament Dress Code -While competing, proper attire is required. No tank tops, short shorts, swimsuits, or spandex. All shirts must have sleeves. NO OBSCENE ATTIRE. All issues with regard to proper attire will be decided upon by the Tournament Management.
