## Rules

- 1) Entrants will use their highest 2023-2024 USBC certified average based on a minimum of 21 games. If no 2023-2024 is available, you will use the highest USBC certified average of 12 games or more, as of October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. All others will be assigned a minimum average of 220 by the tournament directors.
- 2) USBC rule 319a, item #3 and rule 319e applies to all entrants. A bowler must submit an average to the tournament director if during the 12 month period immediately preceding the date and time of bowling: 1) the bowler's accumulated average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used for entry by 15 or more pins; 2) any bowler who has won a prize of \$300 or more must report winnings to the tournament director-this applies even if payment has not been made; 3) any bowler whose 21 game league average as of December 31st,2020 exceeds their 2019-2020 average by 10 or more pins; 4) tournament director reserves the opportunity to adjust a bowler's average upward prior to the bowler's participation. If this occurs, the bowler has the option to accept the adjustment or request a refund of their entry fee.
- 3) Only USBC certified bowlers are eligible for competition. Uncertified bowlers may qualify for all USBC services by paying an affiliate membership fee (\$24) prior to bowling.
- 4) Bowlers will bowl four qualifying games. The field will be cut in half and another 4 games will be bowled. The top 5 bowlers will bowl a step ladder final.
- 5) Total pins will carry over from round one to round two.
- 6) Bowlers on the right lane will move one pair of lanes to the right after each game. Bowlers on the left lane will move one pair to the left after each game.
- 7) No blind score shall be permitted. A bowler not ready in their regular turn shall receive a zero for each frame missed.
- 8) All USBC rules applying to tournament play will be strictly enforced.
- 9) Foul language, obscene gestures, abuse of equipment, or display of poor sportsmanship will be grounds for disqualification.
- 10) Tournament entry deadline is 30 minutes prior to the event start time.
- 11) This is a handicap tournament.
- 12) Handicap will be based on 90% of 220.
