- *Members must bowl at least three of the five monthly tournaments to participate in the scholarship tournament in March. Tournaments are open to any current Idaho Falls USBCYA member in good standing.

Entry Fees:

\$20.00 per tournament (Lineage \$10.00, Expenses \$1.00, Scholarships \$9.00)

Awards: The winner in each division of each tournament will receive a plaque and a banner. The banner is a one per lifetime award with additional stars added for each first place finish. Banners will be displayed at the bowling centers during the season and awarded to the recipient at the end of the season. Scholarships will be awarded in each tournament, based on tournament participation in each division (award ratio at least 1 in 5). Each monthly tournament has at least \$120 additional scholarship funds added through corporate and individual scholarship. The final scholarship tournament has at least \$1,000 additional scholarship funds added through corporate and individual sponsorship. All participants in the final scholarship tournament will be awarded a minimum of a \$30 scholarship. All scholarships will be awarded through the SMART program (#10736).

Entry Deadline: Entry deadline is 12:00 p.m. (noon) the Friday before the tournament. If there are still spots, entries will be accepted the day of the tournament. Deposit entries in the Youth box at any Idaho Falls bowling center. Make checks payable to IF USBC. Entries are limited at some centers without pre-registration - if you do not pre-register you WILL NOT be guaranteed a spot. When space and time allow late entries will be accepted until 12:00 P.M. (noon) the day of the tournament or prior to start of squad per tournament director's discretion.

BOWLERS & PARENTS

Bowlers and Parents please read the Tournament Rules. The Bowlers and Parents agrees to follow the "Dress Code" and adhere to the Conduct and Behavior" expectations, as stated in the Tournament Rules.

Dress Code: All participants must wear clothing that covers appropriate body parts. If you are unsure of what are appropriate body parts, then make sure they are covered. NO shirts with offensive sayings or pictures will be allowed. No tank tops or halter tops. If there are any complaints, parents will be made aware of the problem and be asked to talk to their bowler(s).

Conduct and Behavior: Bowlers are expected to act and look like young professionals. Profanity, obscene hand or arm gestures, kicking equipment or throwing objects will not be tolerated. Any person violating this rule will be given a warning, and if he or she continues they will be suspended for the current event and/or the next tournament, as determined by the Tournament Directors. There will be no refunds for events from which bowlers have been suspended.

IDAHO FALLS JUNIOR BOWLERS TOUR RULES AND FORMAT 2024-2025

AVERAGES: Previous year's IFJBT average will be used for entering average. Current IFJBT average will be used for the rest of the 2024-2025 year. If no previous year's book average is available, current average of at least 3 games from an Idaho Falls youth league will be used and adjusted to challenge average per USBC. Bring proof of average. After establishing an IFJBT average, the current IFJBT average will be used for rest of season. The decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329. If a bowler has an average that falls into a higher division for three consecutive tournaments they will be moved up for the season. (This includes the final scholarship tournament). Once a bowler is moved to a higher division, they will not be allowed to go back down for the season. If bowling unopposed in your division, series must be at least IFJBT composite average X 4 minus 20 pins. If scholarship is not awarded in the division monies will be saved and used in the finals.

MEMBERSHIP: The membership year begins on August 1 and ends on July 31 (the USBC membership year). Bowlers must be bowling on a current Idaho Falls league.

FORMAT: Bowlers bowl four games in each tournament moving one pair of lanes to the right after each game. Total pin count for the four games, plus handicap (100% of 220) where applicable, determines the winners in each division.

OIL PATTERN: Oil pattern will be a challenge pattern. The youth committee will chose three different challenge oil patterns that will be used once at each house. House will chose one of the three oil patterns to lay out for their month, only using each pattern once during the bowling season.

Current USBC rules will be used if not covered in the rules governing the Idaho Falls Junior Bowlers Tour.
