- 2.NO REFUNDS will be issued after tournament entry deadline.
- 3. Entry fee is based on the following: Lineage 16.00, Prize fund 18.00, Club Expenses: 1.00 totaling 35.00
- 4. This tournament is USBC certified and all USBC rules and regulations will apply.
- 5. Handicap for this tournament will be 90% of 220.
