## Rules

- Entries open October 16, 2024 and must be postmarked by January 18, 2025.
- NO REFUNDS will be issued after tournament entry deadline.
- Entry fee is based on the following: Linage fee: 16.00, Prize fee: 18.00, Club Expenses: 1.00, totaling an entry fee of 35.00.
- This tournament is USBC certified and all USBC rules and regulations will apply.
- Handicap for this tournament will be computed on 90% of 220 scratch average.
- Entrants must use highest 2023-2024 certified league average of 21 games, and/or as reported on bowl.com. If no previous season average, entrant will be allowed to use the highest current U.S.B.C. certified league average for 12 games or more as of the tournament date. Proof of average must be supplied with entry. Entrant without either average will bowl scratch. It is the bowlers' responsibility to verify their average. Failure to do so could result in disqualification. U.S.B.C. tournament rules 319a-1, 319a 3-5, 319b, and c will apply. Rules 319-a 2, 319-d and 319-e are waived.
- All entrants must be certified through U.S.B.C. and must be members of the National and the Pontiac 600 clubs. If you are not a current member of the National 600 Club, you can contact your league secretary to apply. Pontiac 600 Club dues are \$7.00, and should be submitted with entry, or can be paid at the tournament desk. Yearly dues are valid September- August.
- Awards and money will be returned 100% to participants. There will be at least 1 (one) prize for each 10 (ten) entries or fraction thereof. Awards will be given in the following order: High Actual Game, High Actual Series, High Handicap Game, High Handicap Series.
  - In case of a tie(s), duplicate awards will be given and the prize money divided equally. You may only win one award.
- Bowlers must check in prior to 10:30am, to be eligible for jackpots. Any bowler arriving after a game has started, will be allowed to bowl for score starting in the frame they arrive. A score of "0" for each frame missed will be issued.
- Substitute(s) will be allowed. Walk Ins will be allowed if space is available.
- Dress code: All Entrants must wear appropriate bowling attire. Members must wear Club shirt. Prohibited attire includes, but not limited to: bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tank tops, halter tops, sweat pants, and short shorts.
- No "Card Carrying Pro" may participate in this tournament.
