Our tournament is open to all youth bowlers who are a member of CTF and/or YBC.

In addition to the Singles, Doubles & Team events, we will hold a few special events:

- **Mini 'Sports Shot' Tournament**
Saturday @ 3:30 pm \$20 entry fee
Lanes will be dressed with a competitive 'sports shot' pattern.
- **Skills Competition**
Sunday @ 9:00 am \$10 entry fee
Two Divisions: Averages of 160 and under & 161 and over
Each Bowler attempts a variety of different spares.
1 in 4 (per division) will advance to a 6-frame roll-off.
Ties for 1st place will be broken by a strike-off. Scholarships will be split evenly for all other ties.
- **Early Bird Entry Draw**
Registrations received prior to 6:00 pm on Friday February 14th will be eligible for great prizes by our sponsors!

Youth All Events Scholarship Tournament
Rules (2025)

1. Tournament is open to all Canadian Youth Bowlers who hold a current CTF membership or YBC league bowlers, who elect one of the following options, and are currently bowling in a registered youth league. ***Rule 300d will apply***.

- a) **Current Youth League bowlers who are not members of CTF may pay a \$5.00 participation fee for this event. OR**
- b) **Current Youth League bowlers who are not members of CTF may purchase a CTF Youth affiliate membership by paying affiliated dues of \$30.00.**

Only entrants who are CTF members before participation in the tournament are eligible for CTF Youth Awards.

2. Tournament will be Scratch/Handicap. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between bowlers' average and 210 with no minuses. Rules 319a, 319d and 319c apply.

3. Entering average will be the highest current youth league season average as of December 31st, 2024 with a minimum of 21 games. If no average, then the average as of the date of competition with a minimum of 21 games may be used. If such an average does not exist, then the highest final Youth League average from the 2023-24 season with a minimum of 21 games may be used. All others bowl scratch. The Tournament Committee will verify all entering averages.

4. Entry Fee (3 games) per bowler per event:

NOTE: Optional All Events Entry Fee (once per bowler) \$10.00 (100% returned) must be paid before the bowler starts first shift.

5. Enter as often as you wish. Cash once in Singles, All Events, or with the same partner in Doubles. Teams must change (2) two bowlers to cash again. Teams and Doubles can have any mix – Bantams, Juniors, Intermediates, Seniors, Boys and Girls from any registered youth league in Canada. The bowlers' first appearance in each event shall count toward their 'All Events' total. (CTF Rule 317).

6. Each entry may cash in Handicap or Scratch (not both), to be determined by the higher cash position. If any entry qualifies in both divisions and the prizes are of equal value, the scratch score will take precedence.
7. Teams and Doubles positions- once the competitors have started the first frame, no changes can be made to the line-up.
8. If a team is bowling alone on a pair of lanes, members are allowed to follow each other immediately in order on the alternate lane. Rule 325 does not apply.
9. The EYTBA Tournament Committee reserves the right to adjust averages based on the sport criteria and reserves the right to request proof of CTF membership. All decisions of the Tournament Committee are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with CTF Rules.
10. Entries will be received up to shift time, depending on lane availability. Out of town entries with specified shift times will have priority.
11. Prize payout minimum 1 in 10 entries (minimum 3 spots on handicap side only). Final standings and scholarship payout will be mailed/emailed to all winners on completion of tournament and verification of averages.
12. Scholarships awarded are held in trust until requested, but must be claimed by the recipients twenty fifth (25) birthday. Any unclaimed scholarship awards will be returned to the scholarship fund for reallocation.
13. Tournament is sanctioned through CTF.
