1. USBC Youth Division rules and regulations will govern this tournament. All entrants must be eligible under USBC Rule 400.
2. Tournament is a handicap tournament with an optional boys and girls scratch division. All bowlers are automatically entered into the handicap division and by paying an additional \$13.00 prize fund their scores will also be counted for the boys or girls scratch division.
3. Handicap is based on 90% of 220. Must have current USBC membership.
4. Entering Average to be used for this tournament shall be in the order of:
  - a. Highest average from 2019-20 yearbook with 21 or more games.
  - b. Highest current average with a minimum of 9 games at the time of competition.
  - c. If none, bowler will bowl scratch - 220.
  - d. **Bowlers must show proof of average with copy of 2019-20 yearbook, last league average/standing sheet or signed letter from Association Manager or League Secretary.**
5. FORMAT: Tournament will consist of 5 games bowled on the same pairs of lanes.
6. Entry Fee is \$25.00. Lineage is \$12 and the prize fund is \$13 which will go towards Smart Scholarships along with **\$1,000 added scholarship money from WSUSBC (based on a minimum of 24 bowlers)**. If bowling the optional scratch division there is an additional \$13 prize fund fee.
7. Bowlers are responsible for verifying that their scores are correct on the recap sheet. Any protests affecting scoring, misconduct or playing rules must be reported IMMEDIATELY to the Tournament Management. The decision of the Tournament Management is final.

8. DRESS CODE:
- a. Bowlers must check in wearing appropriate bowling attire and continue with that bowling attire without alterations throughout their event or be subject to disqualification.
  - b. Competitors shall wear a shirt with a collar. The USBC youth jersey bowling shirt is acceptable as well as shirts provided by a bowling center or by a certified bowling manufacturer (such as Storm, Hammer, etc.) are acceptable.
  - c. Boys shall wear pants/slacks, or walking shorts.
  - d. Girls shall wear pants/slacks, skorts, walking shorts (Bermuda shorts) or Capri pants.
  - e. Gym shorts, sweat pants and clothing made of fleece or Lycra/spandex-like material ARE NOT allowed.
  - f. All apparel worn by competitors must be proper fitting.
  - g. Denim material of any color (jeans) will be allowed provided they have no holes from wear or holes in newly purchased pants.
9. DIVISIONS: There are two division for scratch (boys and girls) and one division for handicap.
10. AWARDS: Scholarships will be awarded based on a minimum of 1:6 ratios.
11. No altering of the surface of your bowling ball once competition starts. Microfiber towels and shammy pads are allowed.
