City Open/Women's Doubles Tournament Rules

<u>Eligibility</u>: Tournament is open to all current (2019-20) USBC members (if outside of Central WA USBC Local membership must be purchased \$9.00)

Qualifying Average: Entrants will use their highest USBC certified yearbook average based on the 2018-19 season with a minimum of 21 games, including summer league average. If the bowler has no qualifying average from 2019-20 than they may enter using their highest current (as of date of bowling) certified leagues average of 12 games. All others bowl scratch. See Rules 319a-1 & 2

Average Verification: It is the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction by the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average, per USBC Rule 319 a-3. USBC Rule 319c average of a bowler may be adjusted upward prior to participation will apply. *Tournament Prize Winning Provision Rule 319d and 319e Tournament Average Adjustment Requirement will apply*.

Handicap: Handicap will be based on 100% of 230 for Singles, 100% of 460 for Doubles.

Entry Fees:* \$50 for Team; \$25 Singles. Optional \$5 for All Events. Prize fund: \$13, Expenses \$12 per bowler. Entry fee must accompany tournament entry form. **There will be a \$35.00 NSF fee for any check returned by the Bank.**

Entries Due:* Closing date for paid entries is 2/28/20 all other entries 1/2 hour prior to squad time, providing space available, are subject to \$5.00 per entry late fee that will be added to All events prize fund.

Multiple Entries: An entrant may bowl multiple times in the doubles event but the highest score will be used unless you have changed partners. If bowling multiple singles events, the highest score will be used. All events will use you first score from Doubles and your first score for Singles. Women may enter any division with their scores only counting in the standings for that division.

<u>Check-In Time</u>: All bowlers shall check-in 30 minutes prior to squad time.

Late Bowlers: Late bowlers will not be permitted to make up missed frames, but may start in the frame to which game has progressed to and take zero pins for frames missed.

Lineup Changes: Changes in lineups must be made at the tournament office as early as possible, but in any event not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad. Substitutions may be made at the time of bowling, but must take line up position of absent bowler.

Tournament Payouts: Payouts for Tournament will be: 1 out of 6 entries: Prize fees will be returned 100% within each event. All prize money will be paid within **30 days** of the last scheduled squad unless there is a protest or appeal see Rule 329, which all monies and prizes will be withheld until the protest or appeal is resolved. All prize money for doubles event shall be forwarded to the team Captain, who shall distribute monies to team members. No monies will be distributed until all checks have cleared the bank.

Scheduled: After entry has been accepted and scheduled there will be no refunds. If unable to bowl, it is the responsibility of the bowler to obtain a sub.
