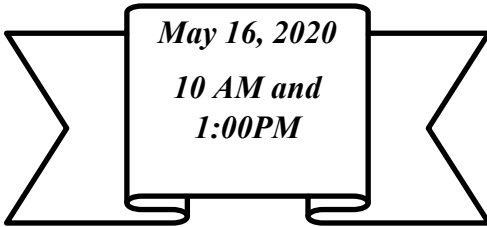

Tournament Rules

- 1. Membership Requirement-Open to all 2019-2020 USBC Youth members. This event will be certified by the United States Bowling Congress**
- 2. Averages must be from a 2019-2020 USBC Youth sanctioned league, 21 games minimum**
- 3. Divisions (Total Team Average)**
 - **Bronze—240 and under**
 - **Silver—241-280**
 - **Gold—281-320**
 - **Platinum—321 and over**
- 3. Dress Code—Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgment when selecting the appropriate attire. Refer to rule 301b.**
- 4. Eating-Smoking-Drinking-Entrants are NOT permitted to smoke or drink alcoholic beverages while participating in the tournament. The center will be a non-smoking venue for all spectators and bowlers. There will be no eating or drinking allowed in the bowlers area during competition.**
- 5. All USBC rules pertaining to equipment will be observed at all times.**
- 6. Etiquette-Bowlers are not permitted to use electronic equipment of any kind in the bowler's area during competition unless the equipment is being used to track the bowler's score with a scoring application. This includes but is not limited to cell phones, pagers, video recorders, cameras, radios, palm pilots, headphones etc. Un-sportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated on the lanes or inside the bowling center. Individuals are subject to removal for engaging in improper tactics or conduct including, but not limited to, physical and verbal abuse toward other persons.**
- 7. Format—This is a doubles event in 4 divisions. Three games will be bowled across 3 pairs of lanes. This is a handicap only tournament and only handicap scores will be used. Entrants may participate only one (1) time in this event.**
- 8. PARTICIPANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AND SUBMIT AN AVERAGE VERIFICATION FORM. This form must be filled out by the league secretary/administrator and received prior to participating.**
- 9. One lane courtesy is recognized and will be enforced.**
- 10. Pacers will not be permitted.**
- 11. Protests—All protests and appeals will be resolved by the tournament director.**
