

QuaranTeen Open

The Quaranteen Open is a virtual Wii Bowling tournament for youth. Kids bowl their games at home and send pictures of their scores. There is no entry fee and there are no prizes. It's all for fun!

How to enter:



1. You'll need to be connected on Facebook. Parents can do this part for their kids. Find the Facebook page "[QuaranTeen Open by tournamentbowl.com](https://www.facebook.com/QuaranTeenOpenbytournamentbowl.com)" and "like" it. That's where you'll submit your scores on the day of the tournament.



2. Go to [tournamentbowl.com](https://www.tournamentbowl.com) and click on *Upcoming Tournaments*. Click on *QuaranTeen Open* and then click on *New Entry Form*. Work through the steps and submit and you're in. You can leave the USBC number blank and you can leave the averages blank.

On Tournament Day:



You play your games at home on your Wii. Take a picture of your final score and send it in a message to the [QuaranTeen Open by tournamentbowl.com](https://www.facebook.com/QuaranTeenOpenbytournamentbowl.com) Facebook page.

Format:

- The tournament starts on 3/28. Bowl three games and submit the scores any time before noon local time. Watch for results on [tournamentbowl.com](https://www.tournamentbowl.com) to see if you've qualified for the next round. One in five entries will qualify for the next round.
- The second round is on 3/29. Begin your three games promptly at 12:00 PM Eastern Standard Time so that it all happens at the same time. These three games must be completed and submitted by 1:00 PM Eastern Standard Time. This round is match play which means each of your games will be against another bowler and you'll get 20 extra pins if you win your match.
- The final round will be 3/29 at 5:00 PM Eastern Standard Time. This round is for the top 8 bowlers and is a bracket format. The first game will be at 5:00 and must be bowled right then. The next game is 5:30 and the final game is 6:00. That is when we can crown our champion.

Additional questions:

- **What does it cost?** Nothing.
- **What do I get if I win?** Nothing- but it will be a lot of fun.
- **What happens if I lose?** Still nothing. It will still be a lot of fun.
- **What happens if I am not honest about my scores?** That's really the only way to spoil your fun.
