YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT

January 28th & 29th, 2017 at Riverside Lanes USBC CERTIFIED

This tournament will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the USBC. Entry into this tournament is open to all <u>vouth members of the USBC</u>. Non–USBC members may purchase a USBC membership for \$10.00 (\$4.00 for national; \$6.00 for local processing) prior to bowling in the tournament. Subject to lane availability. Entries for each squad will close 15 minutes prior to the start of each squad.

EVENTS: Doubles—1 division: handicap; Singles—2 divisions: scratch and handicap

AVERAGES: All entrants will use their **highest current USBC league average of 21 games or more as of December 31, 2016.** If entrant does not have 21 games in, they will use average of 9 games or more as of December 31, 2015. If entrant doe not have an average as of December 31, 2016, they will use the most current average of 9 games at the time of the tournament or average from the 2015-16 season, whichever is highest. *It is the responsibility of the adult leader or individual bowler to furnish the appropriate standing sheet from the league and / or leagues to verify current high average.* Bowlers without an acceptable 9 game average must bowl scratch.

HANDICAP DIVISION: Will be based on 100% of 200 for singles, 100% of 400 for doubles. **SCRATCH DIVISION:** No handicap

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:

DOUBLES: May bowl twice with the same partner, but receive awards only once. Entrants may receive awards more than once if done so with a different partner. **SINGLES:** May bowl as many times as they wish, but receive awards only once.

AWARDS: Estimated awards shall be at least 1:4 entries. All award fee money collected will be returned 100% to participants in the tournament in the form of SMART funds. In the event of a tie, co-champions will be declared and no roll off will occur. Awards will be awarded to winners at the annual meeting & awards banquet.

DRESS CODE: No hats, equipment, or clothing advertising alcohol/tobacco products, no offensive or suggestive shirts. Electronic devices, including cell phones are to be turned off while participating in the tournament.
