NJYBT TOURNAMENT RULES:

- 1) All youth bowlers must be a current USBC certified bowler 20 years old or younger.
- Bowlers will bowl 5 games on same pair of lanes due to COVID 19 regulations. There will be separate Boys & Girls in both Handicap & Scratch Divisions. You must declare your division during pre-registration.
- 3) Oil Pattern WILL BE POSTED WEEK BEFORE EVENT
- 4) <u>ALL BOWLERS BOWLING IN HANDICAP DIVISION MUST SUPPLY PROOF OF AVERAGE</u> (100% of 200)
 - a) Entrants must use the highest USBC certified league average of 15 games or more from 2019-20 fall league as listed on bowl.com
 - b) If No 2019-20 average on Bowl.com, the bowler will use their highest USBC certified league average of 15 games or more as of January 1st, 2020.
 - c) If a certified "Sport" league average is the bowler's only average, it will be adjusted per USBC sport average adjustment chart to determine the average to be used.
 - d) If No a, b, c exist the bowler can use a current average of 9 games or more or past verifiable average whichever is higher. (Tournament Directors decision is final)
 - e) If No a, b, c or d the bowler will use a 200 average.
- 5) There will be Four (4) divisions. Boys Scratch, Girls Scratch, Boys Handicap and Girls Handicap
- 6) The entry fee for the Scholarship Tournament is \$50 for either Scratch or Handicap. Jr Gold option is a separate fee. Bowlers can only bowl in either scratch or handicap. Cannot bowl in both. All bowlers entered in this tournament are eligible for scholarship money. Scholarships will be awarded on a ratio of at least 1: 5 entries
- 7) NO WALKINS FOR THIS EVENT. Checks payable to Louis Mester. Venmo payment to @Louis-Mester or PayPal to <u>strabas67@verizon.net</u> (Only Friends and Family Option will be accepted. - 8) Junior Gold Event is optional, and participants must be entered in the Scholarship Tournament regardless of Handicap or Scratch division. The additional fee for the Junior Gold qualifier is \$25 for U12, \$37.50 for U15 & \$50 for U18 / U20. Entries must be Junior Gold member or can purchase membership online at Bowl.com. Bowlers can only enter the Junior Gold qualifier once. The qualifier is decided by highest 5 game scratch total (NO Handicap) from Youth Scholarship Tournament who entered the qualifier in their age group. Junior Gold qualifying ratio is 1: 4. U20 will compete by themselves and cannot be combined with any other age groups for Junior Gold qualifier. We must have 4 bowlers in each division to have a Junior Gold qualifier. Boys and Girls may be grouped together if ratio 1: 4 is not met and they are in same division. (Example 2 Girls & 2 Boys U 15 may be combined for 1 Junior Gold Spot)
- 9) Dress code No ripped jeans or sweats. No headgear. No shirts with inappropriate language or symbols.
- 10) No use of cellphones or electronic devices once bowling starts.
- 11) Scholarship monies will be returned 100% and will be processed through the SMART PROGRAM.
