Walk-ins on the day of the tournament, \$25.00 per bowler.

#### <u>Rules</u>

- 1. This tournament is a USBC (United States Bowling Congress) Sanctioned Tournament.
- 2. All participants must be USBC Members in the 2020 2021 bowling season and in good standing.
- 3. Youth will use their current high average from the 2020-2021 season of 21 games or more. For youth that do not bowl in the Classic Youth Program you must bring a current league standing sheet showing your average and signed by the league secretary or youth official.
- 4. Adults will use their highest USBC average from bowl.com for the 2019-2020 season. If no bowl.com average bring a current league standing sheet showing your average and signed by the league secretary or league official.
- 5. The competition will be divided into 2 divisions: Youth/Adult and Teen/Adult. Boys and girls will compete in the same age division. Division age groups are as follows:
  - > Youth 12 years old & under as of August 1, 2020
  - ➢ Teen − 13 − 17 years old as of August 1, 2020
  - Adults must be at least 18 years of age as of 8/1/2020 and have an adult USBC Membership in the 2020-2021 season.
- 6. Format: 3 games of bowling by each bowler. Total pins plus handicap will determine the step ladder seed or finishing position. 1 step ladder position per 6 entries with a maximum of 5 per division.
- 7. Stepladder Finals is Scotch Doubles format, single game elimination. Handicap will be half of the two bowlers one game handicap added together.
- 8. Handicap is 90% of 230, dropping all fractions, for all bowlers on a per game basis.
- 9. This tournament will be bowled on Classic Lanes' House Shot.
- 10. Scholarships will be awarded in a 1 out of every 6 ratio in each division, based on the number of entries in each division. No other awards will be given.
- 11. All scholarships will be deposited in the USBC's SMART Fund.
- 12. No adult awards or monies.
- 13. The Tournament Committee has the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 14. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to an upward average adjustment when warranted. Any averages from sport bowling competition must be designated as such and those averages will be adjusted using the 2020 2021 sport average adjustment scale. All entering averages must be USBC certified, or the bowler must bowl scratch (230). Failure to submit complete average information will make entry subject to disqualification. Tournament management reserves the right to adjust a player's average prior to participation in the tournament in accordance with USBC rule 319c. Rules 319d, reporting prior prize winnings, and 319e, average adjustment for entry, apply. All bowlers who have ever been rerated, refused a rerate, or been disqualified in a tournament must report this prior to participating at the tournament for a possible rerate.
- 15. All rules not covered will be governed by the USBC Rule Book.
