### PACIFIC NORTHWEST SENIORS TOURNAMENT

April 2nd, 8th, & 9th, 2017 at San Juan Lanes USBC CERTIFIED

This tournament will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the USBC. Entry into this tournament is open to all USBC (United States Bowling Congress) members, age 50 and over, either bowling in or residing in the jurisdiction of all USBC associations in Washington and British Columbia. Non-members may purchase a membership by paying a fee of \$19.00 (\$10.00 National; \$2.00 State; \$7.00 Local) prior to bowling the tournament. Subject to lane availability, entries for each squad will close 15 minutes before the start of each squad.

**EVENTS:** Handicapped doubles and singles.

AVERAGES: AVERAGES: Will be based on the highest 2015-16 winter league average of 21 games or more. If no winter average, a highest certified 2016 Summer league average may be used, provided they have bowled 21 games or more. If no previous season average, an entrant will use their highest current USBC-certified league average of 21 games or more as of March 1st, 2017. It is the responsibility of the individual bowler or team captain to furnish the appropriate standing sheet from the league and/or leagues to verify the current average, along with a written verification by your league secretary, prior to bowling. Bowlers without an acceptable 21 game average will bowl scratch.

**HANDICAP:** Will be based on 100% of 230.

**DIVISIONS:** Doubles will be in three divisions: (1) 2 Men, (2) Mixed (1 man and 1 woman), or (3) 2 Women, 50 years of age or over. The mixed division may enter with their spouse, regardless of the age of the spouse. Singles will be in two divisions: (1) Men, (2) Women. Each singles division will be divided into two classes. Class "A" includes bowlers 65 years of age or over, Class "B" includes those bowlers 50-64 years of age. Date for determining classifications is the time of first event participation.

### **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:**

**Doubles:** Entrants may bowl twice with the same partner, but cash only once. Entrants may cash more than once, if done with another partner.

**Singles:** Entrants may bowl as many times as they wish, but cash only once.

An additional \$5.00 per person per event tournament expense will be collected from each entry received after Wednesday, March 29th, 2017.

AWARDS: Estimated prizes shall be at least 1:5 entries. ALL PRIZE MONEY COLLECTED WILL BE RETURNED 100% TO PARTICIPANTS IN EACH EVENT OR DIVISION OF EVENT. In the event of a tie, co-champions will be declared and no roll off will occur.

All other rules will be based on the USBC 2016-17 Rule Book
