INLAND NW YOUTH MASTERS RULES AND INFORMATION

- The Inland NW Youth Masters is open to all USBC Youth bowlers. Bowlers must have a current USBC membership for the 2020-2021 season. This tournament will have 2 divisions. All bowlers will bowl scratch. The bowlers division will be based on their age as of January 1st, 2021.
 - a. Division A: Bowlers 11 years and under. LIMITED to 40 entries.
 - b. Division B: Bowlers 12 years and older. LIMITED to 60 entries.
- 2. Division A: Bowlers will bowl 3 games starting at 10am, break for lunch and bowl another 3 games at 2pm. Bowlers in this division will remain on the same pair during each block. Bowler's lane assignments and pairings will change between squads. Bowlers will be provided lunch by Lilac Lanes and Casino. Bowlers in this division will bowl on our house condition.
- 3. Division B: Bowlers will bowl 4 games starting at 10am, break for lunch and bowl another 4 games at 2pm. Bowlers in this division will bowl on "Challenge" lane conditions. Bowlers in this division will move after game 2 of each qualifying block. Individuals on the right lane will move 2 pairs to the right and individuals on the left lane will move two pairs to their left. Bowlers will receive new lane assignments prior to the second qualifying block. The top 25% of bowlers will move on to match play on Sunday. Bowlers will bowl 8 games of round robin match play with 30 bonus pins going to the winner of each match. At the conclusion of the 8 games, a winner will be declared.
- 4. DRESS CODE: Bowling jerseys, center shirts and other commonly accepted tournament bowling attire is required. Slacks are preferred but not required. Dress shorts, golf shorts, skorts, skirts are allowed. Jeans without holes, tears or frays are permitted. Basketball shorts, hats, sleeveless shirts, muscle shirts and tank tops are prohibited. The tournament director has the final say in bowling attire.
- 5. Prize Fund: Prizes will be issued based on a 1:4 ratio. All prize money is awarded to the youth bowler in the form of SMART scholarhships. The top 3 bowlers in each division will receive a trophy.
- 6. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. Bowlers whose behavior disrupts other bowlers will be removed from competition, their remaining scores marked zero and will NOT receive a refund for their entry fees. Damage or abuse of bowling center equipment will result in immediate disqualification.
- 7. Walk-ins will be allowed if the lanes are available.
- 8. Brackets: Each bowler will receive a free bracket upon entry into the tournament. Bowlers will be given the opportunity to purchase additional entries into brackets. Bracket winnings will be distributed as SMART scholarships.
