Fees: \$60* per bowler, per tournament; \$40 per bowler yearly membership fee (due at each bowler's second event of the season). Walk-ins will be accepted on a space available basis.

*Fully paid entries received at least 5 days prior to each event will be \$50.

Absolutely no email, text, phone, or social media messaging entries will be accepted this year. You must register online, by mail, or walk-in.

Full Rules and additional information available on TournamentBowl.com, by request, or on the Facebook Page. Full Rules will be posted at each event. Eligibility: Open to all USBC sanctioned youth bowlers whose birth date is 08/01/2003 or later and all adult (U20) bowlers whose birth date is between 8/1/2001 and 7/31/2003, who are still scholarship eligible.

Junior Gold Qualifying (optional): All events will be Junior Gold Qualifiers, provided there are enough bowlers to make a complete entry. There must be a minimum of 4 U20 bowlers to hold a U20 qualifier. Junior Gold entry fees will be collected at check-in. Do not pre-pay Junior Gold entry.

Format: 5 games of qualifying on a sport pattern, moving lanes after select games. Cut to top 5 in each division for single-elimination stepladder finals

Divisions:

U18 Boys Scratch, U18 Girls Scratch; U15 Boys Scratch, U15 Girls Scratch; U12 Combined Scratch (scratch divisions may be gender and/or age combined if fewer than 6 bowlers in a division)

U20 Combined Scratch (if at least 5 boys and 5 girls, separate divisons will be made)

Mixed Handicap, average up to 189° ; 80% of 200 with a maximum handicap of 90 pins per game.

*Starting average for handicap will be highest book average for 2020-2021. Averages for handicap division will be re-rated after every 15 games. If a bowler's first tour stop is after January 1, 2022, the highest league average (minimum of 12 games) as of 12/31/2021 will be the bowler's starting average.

Cost: \$40 yearly membership fee; \$60 per tournament entry (\$50 if paid 5 days prior); Optional: \$5 brackets, no limit; Junior Gold membership and entry fees, based on Junior Gold division

Dress code: collared shirts or bowling jerseys for boys and girls; slacks or dress shorts for boys; slacks, dress shorts, or skorts for girls. Shorts and skirts/skorts must be at least fingertip length when standing with arms down to the side. No jeans, shorts, sweatpents or yoga-type pants, hats, or sleeveless shirts will be allowed. Any apparel that does not meet these criteria and burnament director's decision is final.

Scholarships: A minimum of 1:5 in each division will receive scholarships at each tournament. (Additional scholarships may be added on the day of the event.) Monthly scholarship payouts will be based on number of entries in the division. A portion of each entry will go to the season finals scholarship pot.

Season Finals: Finals will have no entry fee; all prize money and lineage will come from previous monthly entries and membership fee. Must have a minimum participation of 3 tournaments and be in the top 10 in points of division to be eligible for finals. The format for finals will be determined at a later date and the point requirement may be dropped.
