| | with a minimum of 21 games, verified by a League Secretary. |
| | D) - Minimum age for participation will be 18 for this tournament. |
| | E) - USBC rule 319a.2 - 10 pin rule-will not apply in this tournament. |
| | F) - Each bowlers name should be entered in the proper column on the entry form. The name of the league in |
| | which the average was established shall be entered in the space provided for verification. |
| Rule 4-All Events | - "All-Events" will be conducted in two divisions, actual and handicap. Each bowler will place/cash in one division |
| | (highest) only. Entering All-Events is optional with a fee of \$9.00, payable with the entry form. Entry fees |
