2022 ANNUAL WOMEN'S CITY TOURNAMENT

- 1) The tournament will be held at Crest Lanes. Teams, doubles, and singles may be scheduled as follows: Wednesday, February 2 @ 9:30 a.m.; Thursday, February 3 @ 6:30 p.m.; Saturday, February 5 @ 9:00 a.m.; and Sunday, February 6 @ 2:00 p.m. Additional dates/times are not available.
- 2) Only current female members of the Alcoa-Maryville USBC Association will be permitted to bowl in the 2022 Annual Women's City Tournament. A bowler must be 18 years old or older.
- 3) Any member entering the 2022 Annual Women's City Tournament will use her highest Alcoa-Maryville USBC Association average for the 2020-2021 winter season of at least 21 games or more. If a bowler has no 2020-2021 winter average, she may use her current league average of at least 21 games or more as of January 23, 2022. If a bowler has no current league average, she may use her 2020-2021 summer league average of at least 21 games or more. A bowler with no eligible average must bowl scratch. Entrant must use her highest average whether bowled as a regular member or as a substitute.
- 4) The tournament will be on a handicap basis of 90% of 200, unless bowling scratch.
- 5) Lane assignments will be drawn before each team, doubles, and singles event.
- 6) Each bowler may bowl up to three (3) team events; however, not more than two (2) members of a four (4) person team will be allowed to bowl together on another team. Each bowler may bowl up to three (3) doubles and three (3) singles events. A bowler can only place once with the same doubles partner and only once in the singles event. If an entrant bowls doubles, she does **NOT** have to bowl singles and vice versa. To be eligible for all-events, an individual must bowl singles, doubles, team, and pay the \$2 all-events fee. **REMEMBER – THE FIRST SCORE ROLLED IN ANY EVENT WILL COUNT FOR ALL-EVENTS.**
- 7) Bowlers will be required to report 30 minutes prior to their scheduled bowling time. Substitutions should be made prior to the scheduled bowling time. A bowler arriving late may bowl but will be required to begin bowling in the current frame and no score given for the missed frames. If a doubles bowler is late, the partner will be allowed to bowl her singles event first. If the late bowler does not show for the second event, the partner may bowl her part of the doubles event to qualify for all-events. If the late bowler was replaced with a substitute, the substitute will be allowed to roll the series.
- 8) Previous tournament winnings in a single tournament will not have to be reported.
- 9) Prize money will be awarded to the top six positions in each of the four events. All-Events will be paid on a handicap basis and a bowler can place only once. The bowler with the high scratch game will receive a \$15 cash award. The bowler with the high scratch series will receive a \$15 cash award.
- 10) **Entry deadline for the 2022 Annual Women's City Tournament will be Monday, January 31, 2022.** Entry form and fees must be submitted together unless the entry is completed online at the tournament website www.tournamentbowl.com.
