- 1. Entrants must be a USBC Certified Youth Bowler for the 2021-2022 Season in good standing.
- 2. The tournament will have a Scratch and Handicap division.
 - a. Handicap division is open to both boys or girls with an average of 190 and below.
 - b. Scratch Division: A minimum of 12 girls must be entered to have a separate girls division in scratch. If we do not meet that threshold all girls entered will have the option of moving into the boy's division.
- 3. Entrant must pick either the handicap or scratch division.
- 4. Tournament format:
 - a. Handicap Division: Entrants will bowl 3 games. 1 in 4 or a majority thereof will move on to the next round. Each subsequent round will be an eliminator format. The final round will be a one game step ladder. The top seed will need to be beaten twice.
 - b. Scratch Division: Entrants will bowl 4 games. 1 in 4 or a majority thereof will move on to the next round. Each subsequent round will be an eliminator format. The final round will be a step ladder final. Top seed will need to be beaten twice.
- 5. Handicap will be 90% of 200
- 6. Averages for Handicap Division: Entrant's average will be determined as follows
 - a. Current average as of May 1st of 21 games or more in a certified youth league. Entrants are required to submit proof of average with entry. Proof of average will be accepted as follows:
 - i. Printed bowler history for every league you bowl in signed by your youth coordinator/center representative verifying accuracy
 - ii. Average verification form completed by youth coordinator/center representative for each league entrant participated in.
 - b. If no current 2021-22 season average of 21 games or more in a certified youth league, entrants 2020-2021 highest average will be used.
 - c. All averages will be verified by tournament management. Anyone found to have supplied a fraudulent average will be disqualified.
- 7. Tournament will be certified through USBC. All USBC Tournament rules will apply. Scholarships will be awarded through the USBC SMART program
- 8. Cost is \$45.00 (\$15.00 lineage/\$30.00 prize fund). Checks to be made out to **Sheridan Lanes.**

Eliminator Format:

After qualifying the field will be cut by a ratio of 1:4 (or a majority there of) of entries per division (handicap, girls scratch, boys scratch). For example: 32 entries the top 8 advance. Of those 8 bowlers they will bowl an additional 2 games. The additional 2 games will be added to the pinfall from qualifying. The field will then be cut by total pin fall. Once we have reached the top 4 in each division we will move on to a one game stepladder final. ****All cuts and the number of bowlers who will advance in each round will be announced the day of the tournament. This number will be determined by entries in each division.

All bowlers who advance from qualifying will receive scholarship awards.

The top qualifier in each division will be awarded the Lou Guttormsen Memorial Scholarship for their high qualifying score.
