Tournament Rules

These rules will be strictly enforced and it is each bowlers responsibility to read these rules

1. Open to all bowlers USBC sanctioned for the current season.. **NO PBA/PWBA BOWLERS ALLOWED.**
2. Max team average is **945 3/2 combination.**
3. **HANDICAP: 100% of 200. Women handicap based on 140 average and above and men handicap based on 160 average and above..** If bowler's average is lower than 140 for women and 160 for men, the lower average will be used for team average , but handicap will be assessed at 140 and 160 respectively.
4. **AVERAGES:** Bowlers must use highest book of 21 games or more for 2020-21, 2019-20 or 2018-19 season. Summer average of 15 games or more as of 8-31-2021 can be used only if bowler has none of the above averages. . If bowler has no 21 game average or 15 game summer average as listed above, bowler must use 200.
5. **NO REFUNDS** – Fees after being received will not be refunded except for dire emergencies; such as strikes, lockouts and acts of God.
6. Substitutes are permitted in this tournament. If a sub begins a game, he must complete the entire tournament.
7. Bowlers can bowl twice but cash only once using highest score for doubles & singles. Team score counts for team bowled.
8. The Tournament Committee's decisions are **FINAL**. The Tournament Committee has the right to adjust bowler averages(prior to bowling) and disqualify any bowlers who are not in compliance the tournament rules.
9. **Tournament Committee has the right to refuse any entry or bowler for this tournament.**
10. Bowlers must use correct names as shown on bowl.com when submitting entry.
11. Team lineups cannot be changed the day of the tournament. Changing lineup will result in disqualification.
