YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT

January 27th & 28th, 2018 at San Juan Lanes

USBC CERTIFIED

This tournament will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the USBC. Entry into this tournament is open to all youth members of the USBC. Non-USBC members may purchase a USBC membership for \$10.00 (\$4.00 for national; \$6.00 for local processing) prior to bowling in the tournament. Subject to lane availability. Entries for each squad will close 15 minutes prior to the start of each squad and based on lane availability.

DIVISIONS: Handicap Doubles, Handicap Singles and Scratch Singles. All age groups will be combined within these three divisions.

AVERAGES: Average used for purpose of handicap will be as follows:

- 1) Highest current USBC league average of 21 games or more as of December 31, 2017.
- 2) Otherwise, use highest average of 9 games or more as of January 20, 2018 or last year's average of 21 games or more whichever is highest (if no 9 game average as of Jan 20th, 2018, use last years).
- 3) If a bowler does not meet any 1 or 2 and can show a current average prior to bowling the tournament for 9 games or more, that average may be used (please provide the last posted standing sheet plus a copy of the recap sheet so we can calculate the average if 9 game standing sheet is not available). We will require the actual standing sheet for final audit of scores. All others must enter with a 210 average or bowl scratch.

HANDICAP DIVISION: Will be based on 100% of 210 for singles, 100% of 420 for doubles.

SCRATCH DIVISION: No handicap

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:

DOUBLES: May bowl twice with the same partner, but receive awards only once. Entrants may receive awards more than once if done so with a different partner.

SINGLES: May bowl as many times as they wish, but receive awards only once.

AWARDS: Estimated awards shall be at least 1:4 entries. All award fee money collected will be returned 100% to participants in awards and scholarships. All scholarships will be submitted to the SMART Program. In the event of a tie, co-champions will be declared and no roll off will occur. Awards will be awarded to winners at the annual meeting & awards banquet.

DRESS CODE: No hats, equipment, or clothing advertising alcohol/tobacco products, no offensive or suggestive shirts. Electronic devices, including cell phones are to be turned off while participating in the tournament.
