

This tournament is certified (#04304) by the United States Bowling Congress and the following rules will be observed.

1. **Eligibility:** Open to all USBC sanctioned youth bowlers whose birth date is 08/01/2004
2. **Cost:** \$80 per doubles team. Limited to 96 bowlers (48 teams)
3. **Entries:** Online entries are encouraged. You may enter by going to www.gicairousbc.com and clicking on the link to TournamentBowl.com. Select upcoming events and then filter by state on NE. Select the event and follow the registration instructions. Walk-ins will be accepted based on availability
4. **Divisions:**
 - U28 Scratch doubles (combined age of both bowlers is 28 or under)
 - Girls Scratch doubles
 - Boys Scratch doubles
 - Mixed Scratch doubles
 - Handicap singles add-on, \$10; (90% of 210 per bowler; no negative handicaps will be applied)

Note: scratch divisions may be combined if there are fewer than 5 mixed scratch doubles entries, the boys scratch and girls scratch will be combined into mixed scratch doubles.

5. Averages for the Handicap division will be the highest book average on bowl.com for the 2021-2022 season. If the bowler does not have an established average on bowl.com, please provide a current league standing sheet. Bowlers unable to provide a valid average will bowl scratch.
6. **Format:** All bowlers will bowl four qualifying games, moving lanes between each game. Movement will be finalized day of tournament.
 - After four qualifying games, there will be a cut to the top 3 doubles teams in each division. Seeded stepladder, single-elimination, one-game total pinfall games will determine the division winners.
 - The combined total of each doubles team will be the team score.
 - Ties for seeding positions and stepladder brackets will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. If a tie still remains after the 9th and 10th frame roll-off, a single ball roll-off will determine the placement or winner.
7. **Scholarships:** Scholarships will be awarded at a minimum of a 1:5 in each division. The amount of scholarship available will be finalized the day of the event. Scholarship money will be deposited into bowlers' SMART accounts within 30 days of the conclusion of the tournament. Additional scholarship money may be added on the day of the tournament.
8. **Tournament Date:** Saturday, 11/5/2022 at Westside Lanes, Grand Island, NE. Check-in will begin at 5:00pm and announcement and practice will begin at 6:00 pm.
9. **Dress Code:** Collared shirts or bowling jerseys for boys and girls; slacks or dress shorts for boys; slacks, dress shorts, or skorts for girls. Shorts and skirts/skorts must be at least fingertip length when standing with arms down to the side. No jeans, shorts, sweatpants or yoga-type pants, hats, or sleeveless shirts will be allowed. Any apparel depicting cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, or weapons will not be allowed.
Tournament director reserves the right to disallow any apparel that does not meet these criteria and tournament director's decision is final.
10. All current USBC rules applying to equipment and weight/balance holes will be enforced. The USBC playing rules will cover any situations
