**TOURNAMENT RULES**

- Junior Gold Qualifier
  - The Junior Gold Qualifier Tournament, shall be conducted by the Greater Killeen-Fort Hood USBC in conjunction with the Youth City Championship Tournament.
  - It shall be sanctioned by the USBC Junior Gold and shall be scratch event.
  - All youth bowlers entered in the Youth City Championship Tournament are eligible to enter the Junior Gold Qualifier.
  - Youth bowlers must have a current USBC Card and USBC Junior Gold Membership.
  - Youth bowlers must have their Junior Gold Membership prior to beginning the tournament.
- ENTRY FEE.** The entry fee is \$40.00 per bowler (in addition to the entry fee for youth city). Payment of entry fees must accompany entry application. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Refunds shall not be permitted unless the division fails to field the required minimum. There shall be a \$25 fee on any returned checks. Bowlers with a returned check will not be permitted to write checks for future association tournaments. Entries accepted up to squad start time. **MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO GREATER KILLEEN FORT HOOD USBC.**
- DIVISIONS.** This tournament has two divisions (boys division and girls division); all bowlers will be competing together regardless of U12, U15, U18, and U20 in each division. Each division must have at least 5 entries. If any division fails to field the required minimum, then the entry fee will be returned.
- EVENTS.** Events scores will include first scores bowled in the Youth City Championship Team Event, Doubles Event, and Singles Event. All scores will be scratch.
- CHECK-IN.** All participants must have a **2022-2023** USBC membership card and USBC Junior Gold Card. Original entries USBC cards will be verified by the Association Manager. Junior Gold Memberships can be purchased on site.

**6. PRIZES**

- Prize fees shall be returned 100%.
  - Winner is determined by the bowler with the highest scratch total pins after 3 games.
  - There shall be at least 1 in 5 ratio for earning the Junior Gold entry.
  - Division winners will receive a paid entry to Junior Gold National Tournament or if previously qualified, they may receive the scholarship with the next bowler qualifying for the paid entry. Scholarship based on a ratio of 1 in 5 will go to the non-advancing bowlers in their respective division. (No travel reimbursement or stipend will be provided to these bowlers.).
  - In the event of a tie for first place in any event, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll off.
  - Each division will have their own prize fund.
  - If there are any remaining funds in a division, scholarship prize funds will go to non-advancing bowlers in their respective division. All prize money collected will be returned 100% to bowlers in form of an entry or scholarship money placed in the USBC SMART Fund.
- This qualifier is NOT a premier event.
  - PROTESTS & APPEALS.** The tournament director shall decide any question not covered by these tournament rules and shall have authority to hear and act on all protests concerning the tournament.
  - If the Junior Gold bowler advancing must withdraw from the National Junior Gold Tournament immediately inform the Association Manager at [manager@bowkilleenforthood.org](mailto:manager@bowkilleenforthood.org). The Association Manager will advise USBC of the withdrawal and notify the next qualified individual. (In the event that all the qualified boys have earned or declined a slot the spot will be offered to the next qualified girl or vice versa).
  - COMBINED DIVISION.** Upon USBC approval and at the discretion of the Tournament Director, if the required number of entries are not received in each division, then the tournament director can combine boys and girls into a combined division.
