Linda Quayle Scholarship Tournament Rules

1. The **Linda Quayle Scholarship Tournament** will be open to all USBC **Youth Certified members** (in good standings). (#04144)
2. This will be a singles tournament. Bowlers may enter in one (1) division only, but may enter that division as many times as they want (space permitting). A bowler may not place or cash more than once.
3. There will be four (4) divisions—Girl's and Boys's Scratch and Girl's and Boy's Handicap. If there are not enough entries for a division, the bowler will be given the option of entering another division.
4. **Qualifying:** Bowlers will bowl four (4) games across eight (8) lanes. The top five (5) bowlers in each division will advance to the finals. 1:8 will receive scholarship money. In the case of a tie, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.
5. **Finals:** Format will be stair step bowling one (1) game. In the case of a tie there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll off.
6. **Entry Fee** will be \$50 per squad. Lane fees are \$9, expenses are \$1 and \$40 will go to the prize fund from each entry. No entry fees will be returned. Walk-in entry fee will be \$60. The walk-in fee will be charged on October 30.
7. Prize fund will be awarded 100% in the form of scholarships based on a 1:8 ration.
8. All scholarship prizes will be reported to Scholarship Management Accounting Reports for Tenpins (SMART) for disbursement. (SMART #10578)
9. Entering averages for the tournament will be as follows:
 - ◆ Highest 21-22 bowl.com average
 - ◆ If no previous yearbook average, the highest current league average as of October 21, 2022 of 12 or more games will be used. **WRITTEN VERIFICATION OF AVERAGE (COPY OF STANDING SHEET) MUST BE FURNISHED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR BEFORE BOWLING.**
 - ◆ All others will bowl scratch.
 - ◆ False information is subject to automatic disqualification.
10. Handicap will be 90% of 210.
11. There will be **NO** consumption of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products by USBC members during tournament competition. Parents and spectators may not consume alcoholic beverages behind the lanes where USBC bowlers are bowling.
12. **DRESS CODE:** Shorts and skorts must be long enough that the bowler's fingertips do not touch skin when their arms are extended down to their side. No low-cut blouses, see-thru blouses, crop tops or sleeveless tops. Clothing depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, guns or obscene gestures is not allowed. Final decision on attire will be made by the tournament director.
13. **OPTIONAL JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFIER:** There will be a Junior Gold Qualifier held in conjunction with this tournament. (Minimum of four (4) bowlers required to hold the qualifier in any division) The fee for the JG Qualifier will be \$50. This fee is in addition to the tournament entry fee. The JG Qualifier entry fee may be paid with the tournament entry fees or may be paid on date of participation but must be paid before announcements for the squad begins. Bowlers must be JG members. Membership is \$30 and must be purchased online at bowl.com. The optional JG Qualifier portion will use their 4 game scratch score. Entries will be awarded on a ratio of 1:4 entries or major fraction thereof. Bowlers may enter the JG event once during the day. In the event of a tie for the JG spot, a 9th & 10th frame roll off will be done.
14. Unsportsmanlike conduct including but not limited to; striking ball returns or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc could result **in immediate disqualification** and forfeiture of fees paid.
15. USBC TOURNAMENT RULES SHALL APPLY.
