



Allegheny Mountain Youth Singles Championship Tournament Rules

- 1. This tournament is open to all USBC youth bowlers who are sanctioned in a youth league in this association. All 3 games will be bowled on an assigned pair of lanes. Bowl twice but place only once. Only the first scratch series will be counted toward the junior Gold qualifier. The advancer ratio for this tournament will be 1:4. A tie for 1st place will result in a one game roll off. All others will be based on the bowlers high game**
- 2. This will be a singles only tournament and will be divided into a boys and girls division. Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference in the bowler's average and a base score of 220**
- 3. All bowlers will use their current 2022/23 average based on 12 games. Bowlers without 12 games may bowl but will receive no handicap. An average sheet as of February 18th needs to be sent to the tournament manager along with the entry form. Walk-ins will be accepted as long as lane space is available**
- 4. All award funds will be returned 100% in the form of plaques and/or scholarships to be deposited in the bowlers smart account**
- 5. Any bowler wishing to participate in the Jr gold qualifier may do by purchasing a junior gold card and paying the extra fee. All bowlers must have a Jr Gold card before bowling begins.
If there are more than 4 bowlers but not enough to advance a 2nd bowler the USBC E.A.R.P will be used to advance a 2nd bowler**
- 6. Any situation not covered by these rules will be handled by the Tournament committee in accordance with USBC youth rules
